


## Kindergarten Information 2023-2024

Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year! We are looking forward to a fun and successful year in kindergarten. This is an exciting time for you and your child because so many incredible things happen in these next ten short months. You'll be amazed at the things your little one will accomplish this year!

	Your child has been assigned a bus to take to and from school each day. You may also drop off and/or pick up your child from school. Please fill out and sign the Dismissal Procedures form you received at your Gradual Entry conference on 8/28.  Anytime there is a change in this routine please send a note with your child in his or her red folder. If something changes during the school day, please call the school office with dismissal changes. Do not email your child's teacher to let her know of any dismissal changes. It is possible that email isn't checked or that your child's teacher is unable to access email that day. We are unable to let your child go home with a friend or change the usual dismissal procedure without written permission from you.
Transportation	If your child is in a club or after school activity, please send a note each day or one note listing the dates your child is to attend the club/activity. This will help to ensure the safety of your child, which is our priority. Students may only ride home on their assigned bus. Please note that dismissal instructions are most important. It is not necessary to let me know if your child's morning routine changes.
	It is important that you look in your child's backpack each evening. All school news, notes and assignments come home with your child in their red, "Take Home Folder". This folder will come home daily and is to be sent back to school each morning. Each night, please review all items and check for any items that need to be returned to school. All other items should be removed from the red folder. This is our best line of communication. Please place all notes and other important items in this folder, it will be checked each morning. Your child will be responsible for unpacking his or her red folder every day.
School Work	Most of the work your child has done will be sent home in their red folder (also be on the lookout for awesome work displayed around our classroom and in the hallways outside our room). Take some time and go over the work your child has done. Be positive and value the hard work your child has done at school.
	We will send a weekly update via email every Friday afternoon to parents/caregivers. The email will communicate classroom events, schedule updates, and what we learned in comprehension, phonics, math, and content. We encourage you to discuss with your child what they learned during the week.

Lunch	Lunch will be in the cafeteria each day from 12:30-1:00. Cafeteria helpers will be there to assist the children with anything they may need. Your child may bring his/her lunch or they can get a lunch from the cafeteria. Please label lunch boxes or sacks with your child's first and last name.
